Have you heard about Move On When Ready (MOWR)?

What is Move On When Ready?

- This is a new dual enrollment opportunity for students to attend a postsecondary institution full-time during their junior and/or senior year of high school.
- Students will receive high school credit and college credit simultaneously while attending college classes on the college campus full-time. Approved college on-line courses can also be taken that meet high school graduation requirements.
- MOWR provides high school students the opportunity to jump start their postsecondary education during their high school years.
- High school students will be free to “move on” earlier to the next educational level.
- Students will have an educational alternative other than the traditional high school setting or school day structure.
- Students can save money on future college costs since most expenses are paid from the local school system funding.

How to participate in Move On When Ready?

- 1) Must meet with your counselor to discuss the guidelines and responsibilities of the program.
- 2) Complete an application form.
- 3) Select approved courses taken at the college level that meet the student’s high school graduation requirements. **ALL HS requirements, including the GHSGT and EOCTs must be met.**
- 4) Meet the admission requirements of the college the student is attending.
- 5) The student must have attended a public high school in Georgia full-time all year the prior year.

What Else Do You Need To Know?

- 1) Tuition, materials and mandatory fees are paid through local system funds.
- 2) Students can live on campus or commute but are responsible for these expenses.
- 3) All high school End of Course Tests and Georgia High School Graduation testing requirements must be met. Students must have the correct credits that meet TCBOE graduation requirements.
- 4) Classes do not count against the HOPE Scholarship or Grant hours.
