The Troup County Board of Education is requesting proposals to purchase a minimum of 110 75" Promethean ActivPanel 9 interactive displays with installation/cabling and 3 ActivPanel carts at 5 locations. The installation process will require the removal of an existing Promethean Board, projector, audio amplifier, and set of speakers. The existing raceway can be utilized for the new installation. The cables and parts listed below are brand and model specific, and no alternatives can be bid.

The following must be included in the installation cost:

- Removal of existing projector and mounts, either ceiling or wall-mounted, a replacement ceiling tile will be provided for rooms with ceiling-mounted projectors
- Removal of existing cabling
- Removal of existing Promethean board
- Removal of existing wall-mounted audio amplifier
- Removal of existing wall-mounted speakers
- Removal of any unused raceway
- Installation of Promethean ActivPanel
- Mounting of Promethean ActivPanel Titanium interactive display and bracket
- 50' HDMI Cable 4K @ 60Hz, CL3 (must be compatible with a Dell 5590 Laptop utilizing a WD15, WD19, or WD19S USBC Dock)
- HDMI decora-style faceplate
- 2-gang decora faceplate cover
- USB Extender over CAT5E or CAT6
- 50' CAT5E or better patch cable for the USB extender
- Adding additional raceway if necessary (Raceway will be supplied by TCSS)
- Any needed bolts, screws, or zip-ties to accomplish the above
- Removal of all trash from the installation location each day
- Place all removed equipment in a centralized location at each school
