## Teachers, Parents, Students– Working Together for Success

### In the 3rd Grade Classroom

The 3rd grade teachers will work with students and their families to support student success in reading and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:



Teachers will send home weekly fiction/non-fiction passages with higher level questions to increase Lexile levels and reading comprehension.



Teachers will send home weekly homework that includes fact practice to increase fluency for multiplication and division.

### At Home

HCES parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support student success in Reading and Math



Parents will ensure that their student is reading each night and review their homework.



Parents will practice math flashcards with their student to increase math fluency.



### Third Grade Students

Students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school. Students shared the following ideas:



Ask someone to read with them each night for at least 20 minutes.



Complete reading and math homework.
