

Troup County Schools
Nonresident Student Parent/Guardian Information

1. Parents may obtain applications online at www.troup.org or by visiting the Office of Student Assignment located at 100 North Davis Road Building C, LaGrange, Georgia 30240.
2. Travel reimbursements and/or transportation will not be offered by the Troup County School System. Parents must provide transportation and incur all costs associated with transporting the student. Parents/guardians choosing this option assume all costs associated with transporting the student to and from the selected school.
3. Nonresident students who are accepted to attend the Troup County School System will be assigned to the school that is geographically nearest to their residence, provided space is available. If space is unavailable at the nearest school, the nonresident student may apply to the second nearest school. Nonresident students may apply for hardships. The Troup County School System hardship procedures will apply.
4. A \$25 one time, nonrefundable registration fee per student is required at the time of application. Acceptable forms of payment are: cash, money orders, or cashier's checks.
5. The following items must accompany the admission application: complete official transcript or academic record from previous school, complete disciplinary record from all previous schools, complete attendance records from previous school, and any records reflecting the conviction or adjudication of any felonies or delinquent acts.
6. An admission application is required every year for nonresident students attending Troup County Schools. After the initial submission, school records will not be required to accompany the admission application.
7. Tuition payments will be made in two installments, with the first payment due on or before the first day of the first semester and the second payment due on or before the first day of the second semester. Nonpayment of tuition and fees will result in the student being immediately withdrawn from the Troup County School System.
8. Students residing in the State of Georgia outside of Troup County will be charged tuition of \$300. Students residing outside the State of Georgia will be charged tuition of \$5,500.
9. Any student transferring under this policy shall be subject to the eligibility requirements of the Georgia High School Association (GHSA).
10. No applications for PreK will be considered or approved. No applications or transfers to The HOPE Academy shall be considered or approved.
