Truancy Protocol

Referral to Law Enforcement

In accordance with the No Child Left Behind attendance requirement and the Georgia Compulsory Attendance Statute, O.C.G.A. and 20-2-690, *et. seq.*, a parent or legal guardian who fails to send his or her child to school may be charged with a misdemeanor. At its discretion, a court having jurisdiction may subject the parent or guardian to a fine not to exceed \$100.00 per day, imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both if found guilty of violating this statute. Each day's absence shall be considered a separate offense as related to the penalty.
